we will be able to continue visiting various children's homes and going to various schools to interact and talk to them about topics that are affecting them.

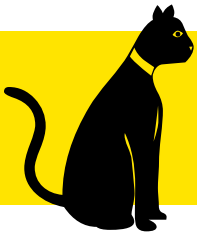

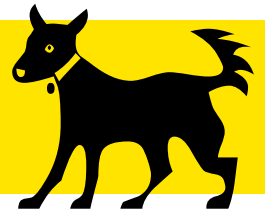
