She currently serves on the board of the Atlantic Coast Conservancy, a land conservation nonprofit that, through its work in the Southeast, has generated more than \$1 million in donations to Pickens County nonprofits and organizations over the past 12 years. These donations have supported local schools, youth sports organizations, the Boys & Girls Club, and many other community initiatives.
